

## K-4 Virtual School 2021-2022

### Program Requirements

Families who wish to be considered for the virtual school option must be able to meet the following program requirements.

- Students will be present with Chromebook camera on in a quiet environment conducive to learning during live instruction and small group time Monday - Friday; parent/guardian will be available as needed during live instruction/small group (grades K-1).
- Students will be present with Chromebook camera on in a quiet environment conducive to learning during live instruction and small group time Monday - Friday (grades 2-4).
- Students will have an established record of strong attendance and maintain strong attendance throughout the year.
- Students will have an established record of completing work and turning in assignments on time.
- Students will maintain grade-level performance or show adequate growth toward grade-level mastery with intervention or special services support.
- Virtual students who receive related services such as speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, etc., will access their services in a virtual format.
- Students will be physically on-site for the completion of quarterly assessments, state-mandated testing, and other services/requirements that may arise.
- Students will **reside** within Bentonville Schools boundaries or are approved to enroll in Bentonville Schools through the School Choice process. "Reside" means to be physically present and to maintain a permanent place of abode for an average of no fewer than four (4) calendar days and nights per week for a primary purpose other than school attendance.
- 2020-21 student math and literacy assessment results will drive discussions between home and school, when needed, to determine the appropriateness of an individual student's placement in virtual school.
- All incoming kindergarten students and new enrollees will be required to complete on-site math and literacy screeners.
