4. Talk with your 8th grader.

During the SSP

1. Bring your 8th grade student. We will provide a note for the absence.
2. Meet a high school counselor for about an hour.
3. Share your hobbies and career pathway interests.
4. Tell us what you want to be when you grow up.
5. Tell us what you love to do with your time.
6. Choose a pathway of core classes (Pre-AP, AP, IB, math, science, etc.).
7. Choose a pathway of electives.
8. Review and include individual courses for that elective pathway.



After the SSP

1. 8th grade courses will be entered in the system by a clerk. You will not have to go into HAC (Home Access Center) and do this like the high school student.
2. You will receive a course request verification in April.
3. Preferential changes end after June 1. See [catalog](#) page 26.
4. Counselors and master schedulers will build a schedule compatible with your 4-year plan. Alternate courses may be pulled from other years of the plan. The plan may not be in exact order by years. Students in higher grade levels get scheduling preference. Space availability may cause your schedule to be some different from your plan.
5. Receive schedules in August at open house.
